Another busy month.....was June even better than May? Here's a summary in case you missed it.



Uniting bourbon casks and new charred oak with rye whiskey casks – rarely used in the Scotch whisky industry – this bottling abounds with notes of pear, candied orange, honeysuckle and clove.

Priced at just £2.80 a dram it's a lovely easy drinking whisky


